History Focus – Learning Journey Medium Term Plan

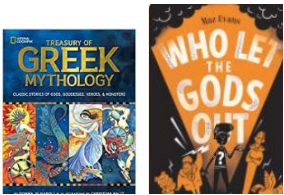
As historians, we will be learning about:
